Linda Abrams is a multi-media artist whose work transcends the outcome of self-expression. With a background in Fine Art, Linda has grown from the academics of drawing and sculpture. Since then, she has grown to enjoy working in many different mediums. From clothing that

becomes sculptures in motion or jewelry that embodies different textures and dimensional surfaces, Linda transforms any medium into a three-dimensional sculpture.

Linda also works on many forms of fabrics with drawing and painting. Intense quilting and thread painting give the art depth and definition. Linda's prints are incorporated into quilts where she uses handmade paper and monoprints, reinforced with silk organza, and then quilted.
