Elizabeth Cassidy is an award-winning New York contemporary mixed media artist, illustrator, writer, and peace lover.

Before she returned to art in 2009, she worked in the New York City advertising field, tried life as a stand-up comic and writer, shared her opinions as a national blogger, volunteered as the New York Coordinator for Project Linus, became a certified creativity coach, and a Reiki Advanced Practitioner.

After realizing Elizabeth wanted to return to making art in 2009, she has been a contemporary mixed-media artist since. She mainly uses the mediums of pen and ink, watercolors, and colored pencils, and I create Fine Art collages and illustrations. Elizabeth has also recently

entered the world of acrylic painting.
