Caryn Coville is a Long Island artist who finds inspiration from nature, her travels, and the beauty she finds in everyday objects. Caryn holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Rochester Institute of Technology. From living in London to New York, her passion for travel has influenced her artwork. Caryn took classes in colored pencils with Arlene Steinberg, studied botanicals in watercolor with Rose Pelicano, and East Asian brush painting with In K Kim, Carolyn Clarke, Sungsook Setton, Sally Feng Fader, Gladys

Stewart, and Gan Yu. Her main concentration now is colored pencil and East Asian brush painting. Caryn is a five-year 'CPX' Signature Member of the Colored Pencil Society of America, an Elected Member of the American Artists Professional League, and a Juried Member of the National Art League. She is a featured artist in several publications, such as Ann Kullberg's Color magazine (April 2023, February 2021, December 2020, May 2019, July 2017, June 2017); Richeson75 Landscape, Seascape & Architecture Exhibition Book (2022, 2020); The Great American Paint In, Artists Sharing Their Pandemic Stories, William C. and Ashley Weinaug; Colored Pencil Society of America's To The Point magazine (May 2022, June 2020, January 2020, June 2018, June 2017, January 2016, June 2015, January 2014), and many more.
