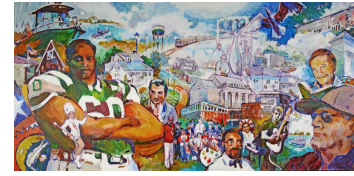

Cedarmere Plein Air Art Contest

Robert B. Sargent: Cedarmere, Roslyn Harbor, *Cedarmere Plein Air Art Contest*, 10/7-10/9; Reception: 11/5. Notes: Art Guild artists are invited to participate in the Second Cedarmere Plein-Air Art Contest on October 7-9. A display of art and prizes will be awarded at a reception on Sunday, November 5 at 3 p.m. at Cedarmere: 225 Bryant Avenue, Roslyn Harbor, NY 11576. The event honors William Cullen Bryant, whose poems and essays influenced the first wave of American artists, now called The Hudson River School, Bryant's close friends. Until the early 19th century landscape was not thought to be an important subject for great art, but by 1850, landscapes dominated the art world. And the uniqueness of the American landscape was recognized. Cedarmere, on the National Historic Register, is on seven acres, with a pond and many gardens, adjacent to Hempstead Harbor. It is the best site on Long Island to appreciate and enjoy the inspiration Nature provided to the first American artists. The judge is Stephanie Navon Jacobson, an instructor at The Art Guild, The Art League of Long Island, and a professor of art at St. John's University. On-site registration is on Saturday and Sunday, Oct 7 and 8, from 9 a.m. to noon; art must be submitted by Monday, October 9.
