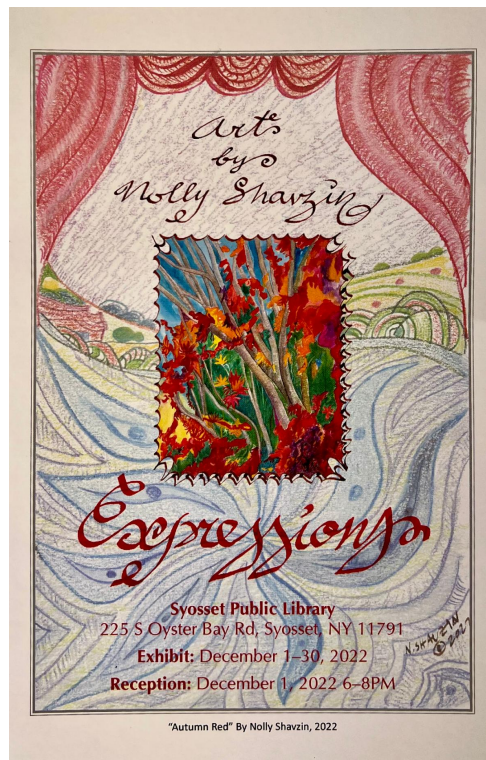

Our December Member Spotlight!

Noel (Nolly) Shavzin



Member Artist of The Art Guild

Nolly is a Long Island-based artist who takes inspiration from the intensity of our landscapes. His earlier works feature inked outlines with colored pencils added to breathe life into those images.

Nolly mainly uses watercolor paints, water-soluble pastels, and watercolor pencils. This combination allows him to achieve intense colors in his work. Nolly's style deviates from pure watercolor studies while bringing a sense of curiosity to each piece I create.

Nolly began his studies in the late 1960s, attending the Grekov State Art School in Odessa, Ukraine. He continued his art education in New York at Pratt Institute, earning bachelor's degrees in Fine Art and Art Education in 1974 and an MA in Printmaking from Pratt Institute in 1977. Nolly's culture shock from transitioning to different cultures fostered different styles, which gave way and a sense of artistic freedom and experimentation.
